

Recently, I discovered something that I think most young children would enjoy. There is a Web site, www.kidmusic.com, that makes Christian CDs that incorporate the child's name in the songs. They are familiar church tunes such as "Jesus Loves Me" and "This Little Light of Mine" that are performed in an upbeat, light, pop style. The site includes a long list of phonetically spelled names that have been set to music.

When you order, tell the company the correct spelling of the name and it will be stamped on the CD. The company also offers lullables, original songs and Christmas music. You can place orders by calling (843) 901-9944.
